A dance performed wearing shoes fitted with metal taps, characterized by rhythmical tapping of the toes and heels




HIPHOP

ACROBATICS ENROLMENT INFORMATION

ACROBATICS PROGRAM & LEVEL REQUIREMENTS

Our Acrobatics Program is designed to safely and progressively build strength, flexibility, balance, tumbling skills, and performance quality. Acrobatics levels are not determined by age or years of experience, but by the skills each student can confidently and consistently demonstrate. This ensures every dancer learns in an environment that is both safe and developmentally appropriate. For safety and quality of learning, all acrobatics classes are capped at a maximum of 18 enrolled students.

ACROBATICS CLASS PLACEMENT

All acrobatics class placements are determined by our qualified acrobatics teachers. They assess each student's demonstrated skills, technique, strength, and readiness to ensure your child is placed in the correct level for their growth and safety. Students may be moved to the next level or offered recommendations for progression based on the teacher's professional expertise and understanding of safe acro development. For safety reasons, placement is never based on age, friendship groups, or the length of time a student has been dancing.

ACROBATICS COMPETITION CLASSES (INVITE ONLY)

Our Acro Competition classes are invite-only and designed for selected students who demonstrate strong technique, control, performance quality, and a consistent commitment to training.

Selection is based on a combination of:

- Skill level
- Technical readiness
- Strength and body control
- Dance ability and performance quality
- Safe execution of required tumbling elements
- Age suitability for competition divisions

These classes focus on polished performance routines, advanced partnering work, and high-level tumbling appropriate for competitions. Invitations are reviewed annually to ensure each student remains in the class best suited to their growth, confidence, and safety.

LEVEL 1 — TUESDAY 4-5PM (BEGINNER)

Level 1 is our foundation acrobatics class, ideal for students who are new to acro or still developing essential strength and balance.

Students will learn:

- Bridge from standing
- Stand up from bridge
- Kick over from bridge
 - Cartwheels
 - Handstands
 - Headstands
 - Chin stands

Students must demonstrate safe, controlled entry and exit for all skills before progressing to Level 2.

LEVEL 2 — TUESDAY 5-6PM (INTERMEDIATE)

Level 2 is suitable for students who have confidently mastered all Level 1 skills.

This class includes:

- Front walkovers
- Back walkovers
- Handstand walking
 - Elbow stands
 - Round offs
- Preparatory drills for aerials and back handsprings

Students must show consistent technique and body control before being considered for Level 3.

LEVEL 3 — TUESDAY 6:00-7:00PM (ADVANCED)

Level 3 is designed for experienced acrobats who have clearly mastered Level 1 and 2 foundational skills.

Students will work on advanced tumbling and performance-focused acro such as:

- Front aerials
- Side aerials
- Back handsprings
- Back tucks (standing and running)

This class focuses heavily on power, technique, control, and performance readiness.

JUNIOR ACROBATICS — SATURDAY 9:30-10:30AM (MIXED LEVEL 1 & 2)

This Saturday class is a general junior-level acrobatics session, perfect for younger students and those building their foundational skills.

Students will work on a combination of Level 1 and Level 2 concepts, including:

- Basic tumbling foundations
- Strength and flexibility
- Safe progression techniques
- Early walkover development
- Confidence-building acro foundations

This class is a great introduction before beginning the progressive Tuesday Level Pathway.

All students are required to wear appropriate clothing and footwear outlined below suitable for the classes they are enrolled into. ShowBiz Branded uniform is available to purchase online. Sample sizes are available in studio.
HAIR MUST BE TIED BACK FOR ALL CLASSES & IN A BUN FOR BALLET.
All elite class students are required to purchase the full school uniform.

Soft pink ballet shoes – Leotard and tights must be worn to all classes. A classical skirt may be worn. NO BAGGY CLOTHES. Hair is to be in a neat bun with all hair away from the face. If your hair is too short to be in a bun then a head band may be worn to keep all loose hairs away from the face

Jazz, Musical Theatre & Song & Dance

Black soft Jazz Shoes – leotard/crop/ singlet/t-shirt with leggings/shorts/dance skirt

Hip Hop

Sneakers/Runners – Trackies/Shorts/Leggings and t-shirt, no denim

Acrobatics

Bare Foot – leotard/crop/Singlet with shorts/leggings

Tap

Tan tap shoes for girls, black for boys and senior students- leotard/crop/ singlet/t-shirt with leggings/shorts/dance skirt

Contemporary/ Lyrical

Foot Paws - leotard/crop/ singlet/t-shirt with leggings/shorts/dance skirt

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2026 COMPETITION TEAMS

The ShowBiz Performing Arts Studios 2026 Competition Teams are designed for dancers who are ready to take their training and performance to the next level. These teams represent the highest standard of commitment, teamwork, and artistry within the studio, performing at major competitions and community events across Victoria. Dancers selected for our elite program embody the ShowBiz values of discipline, determination, and creativity — striving for excellence both in and out of the studio.

Each age-based crew trains together weekly in specialised competition classes focused on choreography, performance, and stage presence. Members also receive unlimited access to all recreational and examination classes, ensuring they can continue developing across multiple dance styles without additional cost. Our capped-fee structure makes it possible for passionate students to train more frequently, build stronger technique, and experience the full breadth of ShowBiz's training opportunities.

As part of their development, all competition team members are encouraged to enrol in ballet to refine control, posture, and artistry, and in jazz and technique classes to enhance flexibility, precision, and musicality. In 2026, dancers can also add Acro to their timetable at no extra cost, building strength, agility, and versatility — skills that have become increasingly valuable in today's competitive dance landscape.

Throughout the year, teams will participate in approximately three to four group competitions, gaining valuable stage experience, confidence, and exposure to professional adjudication. They'll also have opportunities to perform at major events including Moomba 2026 and the Melbourne Royal Show, as well as in ShowBiz's own annual concerts and showcases. Competition team dancers receive priority access and a 10% discount to our mid-year musical, Matilda The Musical, and enjoy first access to private coaching at standard studio rates.

Members of the Elite Competition Teams are held to a high standard of commitment. A minimum 90% attendance rate is required, and attendance at all competitions is mandatory to preserve the integrity of the choreography and team unity. Dancers are also expected to uphold professional presentation standards — wearing their official ShowBiz Competition Crew Jacket, all-black attire to all rehearsals, and maintaining neat hair, no excessive jewellery, and a professional appearance. Uniform and presentation are seen as reflections of discipline, pride, and leadership within the ShowBiz community.

How do we Stay Up to Date with Information?

We have numerous ways of staying connected, All correspondence gets emailed out regularly, So be sure to give us your most regularly used email address. We also have a private Facebook Group that we post up live videos from time to time, chat and share and ask feedback from our families. We will also from time to time send out an SMS if there are any urgent messages to be sent out, so please make sure your phone number is updated regularly.

We also encourage our families to pick up the phone or come in from time to time to check in and see if there is any information required.

Can I watch the class?

All parents are welcome to view our classes via our viewing windows. We do not allow parents/guests inside the studios unless asked by the teacher. We do not allow photography to be taken under any circumstances. The safety and protection of our students is paramount. If students are getting distracted then the teacher may ask that you kindly give the students a moment to settle.

Is there a uniform?

Yes, we have an optional official, but highly recommended uniform for all dancers. All black attire is expected across all our classes except ballet where any coloured leotard, tights and a skirt will be worn along with hair in a bun. Minimal jewelery and hair tied off face at all times is required in all classes.

Is there a concert?

Yes. The concert is the highlight of the year! It's a wonderful opportunity for all students to dance up on stage for an audience of family and friends. Our 2026 concert has been booked at the ClockTower Centre in Moonee Ponds for Saturday 7th November.


Are there exams?

In 2026 students may be offered the opportunity to sit their Comdance Examinations in Ballet and/or Tap. The selection process will be determined by our staff. Students may need to take two years to reach the required standard to be allowed to sit exams. Students will be required to attend their weekly exam class and maintain a 90% attendance rate along with an extra mandatory exam intensive block on Friday's beginning June 5th 2026 up until exams take place in early/mid August.

Is there a Mid Year performance?
